Kadiatu Koroma was born on 10 September 1988, in a village called Bornday, in the Koya Chiefdom Port Loko District, Sierra Leone. She went to School but dropped out at primary level due to inadequate resources from her parents. Kadiatu lost her father when she was in a tender age.



These circumstances gave cause for her to be forced into early marriage. Although this marriage only lasted for a period of two years. She met another man, with whom she has two children (a boy and a girl). It was a trying time for her. As she suffered a lot of domestic violence, mentally and physically and was eventually driven out by her second husband with the two children. She went through very difficult times in caring for herself and the children as she alone carried the entire burden on her shoulders.

After three years of tremendous suffering, she heard that a training programme was going to be established at Masiaka by Kabor Project, and made up in her heart to be part of this training. Without failing, she took a bold step and registered with Kabor Project for training in catering and handicrafts.

Kadiatu Koroma is very intelligent and hard working. She is one of the twenty girls who have just completed training in Tie-Dyeing and Bead work.
