

## boost evaluates London Development Agency project



Following the successful completion of the London Development Agency (LDA) funded Pathways to Progression (P2P) project in October; boost is now conducting the final evaluation.

The P2P project was managed by boost and delivered across London by four delivery partners: asphaleia training, Phoenix Community Care, Central Eltham Youth Project and Shaw Trust. To complete the evaluation, boost will be analysing project data, surveying partners and obtaining feedback from the 14-19 year olds supported through the project via an online survey specially designed to appeal to young people.

“We feel this is a fantastic opportunity to evaluate the success of the project in terms of impact on young people and identifying lessons learnt. The final evaluation report, containing comprehensive quantitative and qualitative analyses, will be presented to the LDA in December.
